Thank you so much for your support over the past year! I'm happy to share with you the work we've accomplished because of your involvement. It truly takes a village to help our neighbors in need. Whether you volunteered, donated, or attended a Meals on Wheels event, we wouldn't be able to do this without you.

Our fiscal year began in April 2021 just as we entered year two of the pandemic. With the onset of the pandemic, we experienced a huge increase in the need for homedelivered meals and this need didn't let up in the second year. In total, our community-supported COVID-19 response enabled our network to provide nearly 360,000 meals to new recipients. It was an amazing achievement for our members to quickly coordinate and deliver the additional meals, and then sustain these increased numbers.

At the close of 2021, our 32 member programs continued to serve 63% more meals than they did prior to the pandemic. In addition to meeting this dramatic increase in demand, I'm proud of the work our collaborative

has accomplished providing meals for previously underserved communities. We've grown our cultural meal options by working with organizations rooted in these communities. In 2021, we welcomed new member organizations Al-Maa'uun to better serve the Muslim and East African communities and SEWA-AIFW to serve the South Asian/Indian community.

Providing delicious, nutritious, and diverse menu options for every neighborhood in the Twin Cities remains a priority as we look to the future. In the following pages you will learn more details about our work, and we hope you are inspired to join us once again in 2022-23.
