### Before your first delivery

- ✓ Receive directions and arrival time for pick-up site
- ✓ Complete a volunteer application form
- ✓ Complete a background check release form
- ✓ Provide proof of valid driver's license and current auto insurance

### What you can expect from us

- Receive training on delivering meals
- Specific driving directions, clear addresses, and maps
- Meals will be packed and ready for your pick-up and delivery
- Staff will respond promptly to any questions or concerns



# **FAQs: Delivering Meals**

#### Who Receives Meals?

 The majority are seniors living in their homes over the age of 60 and younger folks with disabilities. Recipients use Meals on Wheels because they have difficulty preparing daily, well-balanced meals and need a daily check-in.

#### What if I get lost?

 Route maps are easy to follow and the site director will guide you through to get started.

#### What if I can't go on my scheduled day?

 An alternate can go in your place, but if that is not possible, notify the Meals on Wheels site coordinator in advance.

#### What if someone doesn't answer the door?

The site coordinator will explain to you how to handle the situation. Usually, you
return the meal to the site and notify the coordinator.

#### Do I need a big van or truck to haul the meals?

Any vehicle is adequate.

#### How much time will the delivery take?

Deliveries usually take less than one hour.



# **MOW Expectations**

- Volunteers are prompt and reliable
- Volunteers follow food safety instructions
- Drive carefully, abide by traffic laws, and maintain current insurance
- Be courteous and friendly to all recipients. Remember, you may be the only person they see on some days!
- Share any concerns you have about a recipient's health or safety with the coordinator.
